

Compliance declaration

Reg. (UE) 1149/2020

Concerning the registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemicals (REACH) as regards diisocyanates.

Diisocyanates are used as basic chemical components in a wide range of sectors and applications as a reactive component to make polyurethanes; these substances are subject to a harmonized classification (Reg. 1272/2008 CLP) as skin sensitizers of cat. I and as sensitizers of the respiratory tract of cat. I. In our sector they are mainly used in the hardeners of 2K PU finishes, both solvent-based and water-based, in 1K PU sealants, in multi-component PU-cement systems.

SECTORS OF USE AND DEADLINES

IN CASE OF PRODUCTS CONTAINING DIISOCYANATES IN CONCENTRATION > 0.1%

- *Restrictions on placing on the market:* from 24/02/22 there will be on the label a reference to Reg. 1149/20 which warns the applicators to carry out specific training by 08/24/23.
- *Restrictions to use:* from **24/08/23** applicators must have successfully completed a specific training.

stay within the limits set by the Regulation 1149**

therefore

- **There are no restrictions on sale or distribution**
- **No specific training is required for applicators**
